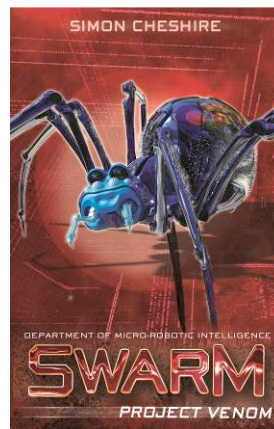
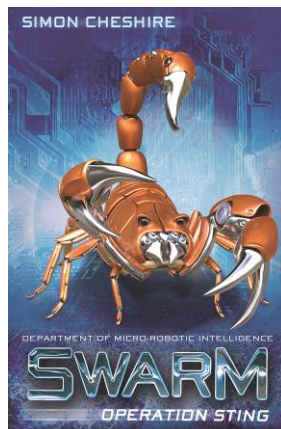


SWARM
