The Tree Next Door

How To video:






Materials needed:

- · Two squares of paper (we've provided some scrap paper, but you can also use old proofs, damaged stock or any odds and ends that you have lying around!)
- · Glue (PVA works best)
- · Scissors


Step 1 • Fold the paper square in half horizontally and then fold it in half diagonally – to create the below fold pattern.









Step 2 · Cut half-way along the four central folds, using the dotted lines as guidance.






Step 3 \cdot Fold Flap A and Flap B inwards to the fold line to create the first point of the star.







Step 4 · Repeat Step 3 to the remaining flaps to create three more points of the star.







Step 5 • Glue the top face of Flap A to the bottom face of Flap B, securing the point. This will help to make it three dimensional.




Step 6 · Repeat Step 5 for all remaining points of the star.





Step 7 • Repeat Steps 1 - 6, creating a second star.





Step 8 · Glue the base of all the flaps on Star 1 and also on Star 2. Then stick both stars together at an angle, creating the below shape. Your star should have eight points!
