

NIBBLES Activity Pack -by EMMA VARLETT

Slime Recipe

Try out Nibbles' favourite recipe - if you dare!

Takes 10 minutes to make!

- 100ml PVA white glue (children's craft glue)
- ½ tsp bicarbonate of soda
- gel food colouring
- 1 tsp contact lens cleaning solution (must contain boric acid)
- glitt<mark>er (</mark>opt<mark>ion</mark>al)

Instructions

- 1. Squeeze the glue into a mixing bowl. Add the bicarbonate of soda and mix well.
- 2. Add drops of your chosen gel food colouring while mixing until you reach your desired colour. The more you add, the brighter the colour will be.
- 3. Add 1 tsp contact lens solution and mix well for a minute.
- 4. Once it has formed, take it out and knead it in the bowl with your hands. It will be very sticky at first, but after about a minute or so you'll have a smooth ball of slime.
- 5. Add glitter (optional) and work in with your hands. Store in a pot with a lid.
